The Cleveland Clinic this week celebrates the opening of two landmarks that blend modern, open spaces and contemporary artwork with the latest in medical technology. ¶ The Sydell and Arnold Miller Family Pavilion and the adjacent Glickman Tower, built at a cost of more than \$630 million, represent the largest expansion in the Clinic's history. ¶ They will house the Clinic's Heart and Vascular Institute and the Glickman Urological and Kidney Institute and usher in an era of patient-centered care. ¶ Opening celebrations start Friday and continue with an open house Sunday.
